SPARKS' PERSPECTIVE

Last January, the Department of Agriculture and Industries took the first step in establishing the new Alabama Premises Registration System as part of the National Animal Identification System (NAIS). I am extremely proud of how well this program has been going. The success of the project was made possible only because it was so openly received by livestock owners across the state. In one year, we have registered approximately 2,000 premises in Alabama, but there are still many that need to be registered.

Diseases such as BSE, commonly known as "mad cow disease," and avian influenza have greatly intensified public interest in developing a national animal identification program. Alabama was one of the first states in the region to officially implement procedures designed to ID livestock and poultry to protect animal and human health.

This program provides an efficient and straightforward process of identification registration that can help prepare you for the future, especially in the cattle industry. The Animal Industries Division's staff has worked hard to share information with producers across the state to help demonstrate the benefits of Premises ID. We attended cattle sales at five stockyards across the state and worked with the AL Cattlemen's Association, AL Farmers Federation, Cooperative Extension System, Beef Cattle Improvement Association, and Auburn University to make sure everyone knows how easy it can be to protect your livestock and

your livelihood as a cattle producer.

Spry Mitchell in Florence, Alabama is a good example of being prepared for the market. Spry knows that to be able to export his high quality beef to countries like Japan, he must be able to prove the date of origin to even be considered by Japanese buyers. As a result, his business, Mitchell & Spry Enterprises, has already established birth records for over 500 calves. Even though there is no guarantee that the buyers will order from Mitchell & Spry, the co-owner is optimistic. Spry wants to be sure his cattle are qualified so he can take advantage of premiums attached to cattle that have been registered and are traceable.

We will continue to work with producers in 2006 to keep them aware of updates on this evolving program. The Department has already provided Premises ID training for Extension System and commodity leaders so they can also register premises. Our long term goal is to work in cooperation with the USDA and the livestock industry to establish a system that can identify all premises and animals that have come in contact with a foreign or domestic animal disease within 24 hours. This will also be a valuable tool in our surveillance efforts for avian influenza.

2005 PESTICIDE CLEAN DAY

The Alabama Agriculture & Industries has successfully completed its Pesticide Clean Day Program for 2005. Container collection totals were over 6,800 in Chilton County and over 41,000 in Baldwin County. The Pesticide Clean Day Program allows farmers, nurserymen, and pest control operators to take advantage of safe disposal of unwanted or unused pesticide wastes at no charge.

"This program helps to reduce the amount of unwanted pesticides in barns or storage areas that might otherwise filter into our groundwater," said

Commissioner Ron Sparks. "The Department's Pesticide Management Division has done a great job working with the Alabama Cooperative Extension Service, Legacy, and CAWACO to help our farmers help the environment."

Materials that were accepted for collection include both known and unidentifiable pesticide waste, such as insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, and other products such as defoliant and growth retardants. Products not be accepted were explosives or ordinance materials, petroleum products (such as motor oil), paints, tires, medical

waste, radioactive materials, or seeds.

Sponsors of the two day event include: the Alabama Department of Agriculture & Industries, Alabama Cooperative Extension System, Legacy-Partners in Environmental Education, and CAWACO Resource Conservation and Development Council.


Since the program began, millions of Alabama fruits and vegetables have been served in school lunchrooms.

Master Cattle Producers Training Classes

Beef cattle producers in Alabama and Mississippi can take the Master Cattle Producers Training Program via interactive videoconferencing. The high tech version of the program will be offered in a number of locations around Alabama, including Auburn University, Belle Mina, Headland, Marion Junction, Montgomery, Crossville, and Winfield.

The class will begin Tuesday, January 17, 2006 and will be held weekly through March 14. There will be no class on February 14.

The interactive course is open to any producer interested in learning more about improving production on their beef cattle operations. Sessions will run from 6:30 to 9:00 p.m.

Interactive video allows presenters to reach many geographic locations at once. However, questions can be

asked at any time during the presentations, and all other participants will hear the question and the response. Moderators will be present at each location throughout Alabama to answer additional questions.

Dr. Lisa Kriese-Anderson, an animal scientist with the Alabama Cooperative Extension System, says the program is designed to make cattle farmers aware that they are "food producers" and that current issues pertaining to food safety, beef quality assurance, and consumer

perception of beef products can be improved if research-based production recommendations are practiced.

"Our primary goals are to train Alabama cattle producers to profitably produce safe, wholesome, high quality beef products meeting global and domestic demands, to make producers aware of current and emerging issues pertaining to food safety, beef quality assur-

ance, and consumer perception and to provide producers with training on recommended production practices."

Beef producers enrolled in this program will complete about 20 hours of training which includes the following: Management and Marketing, Nutrition of Beef Cattle, Forage Systems, Reproduction, Health Practices and Handling, The Product: Quality and Yield Grades, Selection for Optimum Genetics, Beef Quality Assurance.

Contact your county Extension office for a complete program and locations with interactive video. Producers should pre-register with your regional Extension animal science agent, or your county Extension office. The registration fee covers the course, written materials and a farm sign earned on the completion of the course. The Master Cattle Producers Training program was developed and is sponsored by the Alabama Cooperative Extension System.
