

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER SEVENTY-EIGHT

WHEREAS, the by-laws of National Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology, Inc. require that an individual be an active member of said Council in order to be an officer; and

WHEREAS, it is a great honor for the State of Alabama to have one of her citizens serve as an officer of the National Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous for Alabamians to be given the opportunity to serve in such a prestigious office:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, George C. Wallace, as Governor of the State of Alabama, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby create the position of ex-officio member of the Alabama Board of Cosmetology to be held by any Alabamian who is an officer of the National Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology, Inc., but is not otherwise a member of the Alabama Board of Cosmetology. The individual who shall serve in this position shall serve as Chairman of the Board. However, said member shall not have a right to vote on any

matter; nor shall he or she receive any compensation, expenses or per diem for attending the meetings of the Board.
