

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 44

WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature has authorized the Governor to execute the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Compact; and

WHEREAS, Article III of this Compact creates the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Authority; and

WHEREAS, Article III of this Compact states that the Authority shall consist of the Governor of each party state and five other citizens of each party state to be appointed by the Governor thereof; and

WHEREAS, there is a serious need for Alabama to have an additional representative on this Authority; and

WHEREAS, Article VI of this Compact states that nothing contained therein shall limit the powers of any party state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GEORGE C. WALLACE, GOVERNOR OF ALABAMA, do hereby direct that an additional representative from Alabama be added to this Authority. This representative shall be designated as the Governor's Representative to the Authority and shall have all the rights, privileges and duties of all other members. His term shall run concurrent with the Governor and until his successor is appointed and qualified. He may be removed with or without cause. I hereby designate Senator L. W. "Red" Noonan as this Representative.
