

at least three householders living nearest the field, woods or swamp, in which the hunt is to be made.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That any person violating the provisions of this act, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, shall be fined not less than twenty nor more than fifty dollars, at the discretion of the jury trying the case. ^{Penalty.}

AN ACT

To repeal in part an act therein named, and for other purposes.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Alabama in General Assembly, convened*; That the 5th section of an act, entitled "An Act to lay off Benton county into Commissioners Districts, and for other purposes," approved December 3rd, 1857, be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as the same relates to the county of Blount.
