SEC. 12. *Be it further enacted*, That the board of education may, in its discretion, institute annual competitive examinations before such persons as the board may select for all applicants for license to teach in the public schools of the school district, including licensed teachers in said schools who are applicants for re-election as teachers.

SEC. 13. *Be it further enacted*, That all laws and parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

AN ACT

[H. B. 921.

To provide for the election of the county superintendent of education by a vote of the legal electors of Covington and Bullock counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Alabama*, That the county superintendent of education of Bullock and Covington counties shall be elected at the general election on the first Monday in August, 1886, by the legal electors of said county, and at the general election every two years thereafter in the same manner as other county officers are elected; and said superintendents term of offices shall begin on the first day of October, 1886, and continue for two years, and they shall hold said office and perform all the duties thereof under the laws governing public schools; and in case of vacancy of said office, the State superintendent of education shall fill said office by appointment, and such appointment shall fill said office until the next regular election thereafter.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That all laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
