SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Alabama,* That section 1 of an act to establish a new charter for the city of Montgomery approved on the 21st day of February, 1893, be amended so as to read as follows: That the city of Montgomery in the county of Montgomery and the State of Alabama, shall include in its corporate limits the territory described as follows: To-wit: The whole of fractional section 12, township 16, range 17, to the west bank of the Alabama river and commencing at the intersection of of Oak and Clayton streets, thence south along centre of said Oak street to what is known as Day street, thence east along centre of said Day street to what is now known as Mobile street, thence in a southerly direction along centre of said Mobile street to what is now known as
