Sec. 15. Be it further enacted, That said board of education shall have the power to buy lands for the purpose of erecting school buildings thereon, or to provide suitable school buildings by rent or purchase, and all necessary furniture, equipments or apparatus, the title to said property to be vested in said board of education and their successors in office. Buildings

Sec. 16. Be it further enacted, That said board of education shall have the power to charge in the several grades of the public schools of the district of Pratt City such incidental or other fees as may be necessary for the conduct of said schools. Fees

Sec. 17. Be it further enacted, That the district of Pratt City, as a separate school district, shall receive a proportionate share of the public school funds as apportioned to Jefferson county, including a pro rata share of the "sixteenth section" fund, and all of the poll tax collected in the corporate limits of said district, and not less than seventy per cent. of license tax collected within the corporation, and all funds set apart by the State for school purposes: Provided, That not more than four per cent. of said fund derived from the State shall be used otherwise than for the payment of teachers employed in the public schools in the district of Pratt City. Sec. 18. Be it further enacted, That all laws and parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal
