

approval except that the present incumbents of the respective offices in said city shall continue to perform the duties and receive the emoluments thereof until their successors have been elected and qualified under the provisions of this act. The general council shall not have authority to add to the salary or compensation of any official or employee whose salary or compensation is fixed by this act.

SEC. 94. Be it further enacted, That the municipal corporation hereby created shall be in all respects the legal successor of the late municipal corporation known as the city of Mobile. Legal successor.

SEC. 95. Be it further enacted, That all laws and parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal.

AN ACT

[s. 628

To create the North River stock law district, in Fayette county, to define the boundaries thereof, and to prescribe penalties for violating the provisions of this act.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Alabama, That a district in Fayette county, to be known as the North River stock law district is hereby created, in which stock is prohibited from running at large. Stock law district.

SEC. 2. Be it further enacted, That the bounds and limits of said North River district are described and set out as follows: Beginning at the S. E. corner of section 23, T. 16, R. 11 west, running west $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence north 1 mile, thence west $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, thence south $\frac{1}{2}$ quarter, thence west $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence south $\frac{1}{2}$ quarter, thence west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, thence north $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, thence quarter mile west, thence north quarter mile, thence west $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence north $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, thence west $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence north to Elyton road west to Atkins Ba- Bounds and limits.
