## INTRODUCTION

The actual compiling of the tombstone inscriptions of Pike County, Alabama, into this arrangement started the last of September, 1970. The index was completed October 26, 1972. This record includes the inscriptions from every ~~white~~ cemetery locatable in the county. The possibility exists that some graveyards have been omitted, but this is due to the lack of knowledge of their locations. This compilation includes approximately 15,400 inscriptions from 126 cemeteries.

This particular project is an off-spring of work started back in the 1950's by individuals who realized the importance of tombstone inscriptions in genealogical and historical research. The Pike County Historical Society began to publish these earlier surveys in its "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society." Miscellaneous cemetery records had appeared in five issues of the quarterly publication when it became evident that a county-wide survey and a single publication was much more desirable.

Original plans called for the extensive use of all previous surveys obtainable in order to avoid duplication of efforts; however, two major problems were encountered, and plans were altered to meet the situation. Apparently some of the earlier surveys were made to satisfy the personal demands of those making them. They did not cover the details needed for this project. Some of the surveys published were made several years ago. Pleas were received to bring the surveys of these hallowed places up to date before publication. Thus, a resurvey was made on many cemeteries and this book reflects the results of the last survey. The earlier surveys were, however, compared for possible missing details.

Due to the tremendous amount of work that would have been involved, ephitaphs are omitted unless they contain information of genealogical or historical value.

During the course of this project we discovered it is an impossibility to make a 100% perfect cemetery survey. Too many factors are involved. We trust that the information shown herein does contain a high degree of accuracy. Our aim was to make this record as complete and accurate as possible.

This entire project has been accomplished through the generous contribution of time and effort by many people to whom I wish again to say "Thank you."

Many supplied data from particular cemeteries and are credited in the list of cemeteries. Others contributed by giving directions necessary to locate a cemetery; their names go unmentioned, but their help is no less appreciated. Two people are deserving of particular note, for their service materially assisted in the overall success of the project. Neither desires to be singled out for particular recognition but both are deserving of it. Mrs. Henry W. Folmar of Goshen contributed heavily in records, and her personal influence contributed to the quality of the completed project. Mr. John P. Johnston of Brundidge supplied many records and was untiring in the diverse types of work involved in a county-wide survey.

It is hoped that this record will become a prime reference source on Pike County, Alabama, and will assist many researchers in the years to come.



- 2 **Allred Cemetery.** Located six miles south of Troy off South Three Notch road. Copied by Ruth McPherson Brown and Eva Cowart in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Pages 13-14 April 1962.
- 3 **Antioch Church.** Located south of Antioch community on Highway 231 between Brundidge and Troy. Copied March 16, 1971 by E. H. Hayes.

- 5 **Ballard's Hill Cemetery.** Located West of Troy-Elba Highway. Copied by John P. Johnston and E. H. Hayes April 1, 1972.
- 6 **Banks Baptist.** Located at Banks, Ala. Copied by John P. Johnston in 1969. Resurveyed by E. H. Hayes Nov. 6, 1971.
- 7 **Banks Methodist.** Located at Banks, Ala. Copied by E. H. Hayes Nov. 6, 1971.
- 8 **Baptist Rest Primitive Baptist Cemetery.** Located south side of Lee Street, Brundidge, Ala. Copied by John P. Johnston in 1969. No burials since the survey was made.
- 9 **Belser Cemetery.** Located north of Ansley, Ala. on the road to Briar Hill. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar and Mrs. W. O. Sanders in April 1967. Brought up to date by Resurvey of E. H. Hayes Jan. 8, 1972.
- 9.1 **Benton Cemetery.** Located on Butter & Egg road on farm of Mr. J. D. Whitehurst between Banks and Troy. One marker, Mary McKerley. Copied by John P. Johnston July 12, 1971.
- 10 **Beulah Cemetery.** Located on South Three-Notch Street, Troy, Ala. Two surveys used Viz: (1) Survey by Girl Scout Cadette troop 172 and Annie Laurie Shirley, Mrs. Tom Dunbar, Leader as recorded in "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society" Vol. 8 No. 3 Pages 1-8 July 1969. (2) Survey of E. H. Hayes Oct 16, 1971.
- 11 **Berry Family or Old Dothan Cemetery.** Located between Monticello and Shiloh. Copied by John P. Johnston June 1971.
- 12 **Bethel Church.** Located between Banks and Brundidge Highway 93. Two Surveys used Viz: (1) John P. Johnston's of 1969 and (2) E. H. Hayes' of Nov. 2, 1971.
- 13 **Boutwell-Bundy Cemetery.** Located in the 3rd 40 directly behind the house on west side of Highway 87 across the Highway from Mr. Ralph Boutwell's house, below Springhill. Copied by John P. Johnston and E. H. Hayes guided by Mr. Ralph Boutwell June 19, 1971. Nine graves were located with names on eight of them.
- 14 **Brooks Family.** Located on land presently owned by Frank King. Copied by John P. Johnston 1969 recorded in "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society" Vol. 9 No. 3. Page 8 July 1970. Three Inscriptions Viz: Emma E., Phebe A. and W. C. Brooks.
- 15 **Brundidge City Cemetery.** Located on South Main Street, Brundidge, Ala. Copied by E. H. Hayes Oct. 5th through 26th 1970 and compared with Survey of John P. Johnston of early 1970.
- 16 **Carroll Cemetery.** Located on land owned by a Mr. Swindall of RFD Troy, Ala. Off Brundidge-Springhill Road. Copied by John P. Johnston. Four inscriptions Viz: Charity, Joannah,

Willis and Infant of Malcolm and Charity Carroll.

- 17 **Carr's Church.** Located on paved county road N.E. of Troy, Ala. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 23, 1971. The section of the cemetery outside of chain link fence not included.
- 18 **Catalpa Cemetery.** Located across road from Ebenezer Baptist Church, Highway 223. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 19 & 23, 1971.
- 19 **Carter Cemetery.** Located on a dirt road that runs from Briar Hill across to Kent. It sits to the right of the road where another dirt road comes straight into it from the south. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. and Joyce Folmar June 8, 1971.
- 20 **Center Ridge Church.** Located east of Highway 87 just above the Coffee County Line. Copied by John P. Johnston May 9, 1971. Unmarked Graves furnished by Mrs. Lula Bundy Rt. 2 Box 277 Troy, Ala. March 27, 1972.
- 21 **Chapel Hill Missionary Baptist Church.** Located north of Troy-Luverne highway in the Rural Home Community. Copied by E. H. Hayes Jan. 8, 1972.
- 22 **China Grove Cemetery.** Located at China Grove. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 23, 1971. Colored section not included.
- 23 **Clayhill Church.** Located at Pronto, Ala. Copied by John P. Johnston 1969 and compared with Survey made by E. H. Hayes Nov. 4, 1971.
- 24 **Connor Family.** Located Range 23 East Sec 19. East of Enon Baptist Church on Sam Ingram farm. Copied by John P. Johnston and E. H. Hayes Nov. 1, 1970. Five Inscriptions. Several unmarked graves.
- 25 **Copeland Cemetery.** Located on East Side of Knox Street, Troy, Ala. Where new housing project begins. Copied by E. H. Hayes May 27, 1971. Three inscriptions Viz: B.R., E.B. and Isaac Copeland.
- 26 **Cotton Cemetery.** Located on land belonging to F. B. Tyner. Copied by John P. Johnston 1969. Nov. 7, 1970 Mr. Fletcher R. Copeland visited this cemetery in company with E. H. Hayes. He furnished additional information from memory as many buried here are his near relatives.
- 27 **Davis Cemetery.** Location from Troy go south on Highway 87 pass paved road (to Pike County Lake) turn right on first dirt road, cross the creek and take 1st dirt road to left. Copied by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar June 20, 1971.
- 28 **Davison Cemetery.** Located on a hill top east of Elam Church which is north of Goshen, Ala. Information herein from the personal files of Mrs. Henry W. Folmar May 21, 1971.
- 28.1 **Dennis Family.** Located S.E. of China Grove. Copied by E. H. Hayes Jan. 8, 1972. Guided by Mrs. Lewis Curtis Burks. Three inscriptions viz: Joseph F. May, Charles A. Dennis and Charles Dennis Cargil.
- 29 **Driggers Cemetery.** Located on land owned by Ferrell Gibson between Antioch church and Brundidge. Copied by John P. Johnston April 17, 1971. Three inscriptions viz: D. & Isaac Carter and Charity Driggers.
- 30 **Ebenezer Baptist Church.** Located on Highway 223 at Catalpa. Copied Feb. 23, 1971 by E. H. Hayes.
- 31 **Elam Church.** Located north of Goshen. First visited by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar in 1965. A second visit made May 17, 1971. Resurveyed by E. H. Hayes March 27, 1972.
- 32 **Enon Baptist Church.** Located in Enon community south of Josie. Copied by E. H. Hayes Jan. 1, 1972.
- 33 **Evans Cemetery.** Located near an old gin two miles east of Goshen. Copied by Ruth McPherson Brown in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society" Vo. II No. 6 Page 12 April 1962. Two inscriptions viz: Mr. & Mrs. Evans.
- 34 **Flowers Family.** Located four miles south of Brundidge on farm of Mr. Rayvon Graham. Copied by John P. Johnston May 15, 1971. Five inscriptions viz: Marendra Carter, Richard Flowers, Lucinda Graves, Hannah and Samuel Wilson.
- 35 **Goodhope Church.** Located off the Troy-Luverne highway. Turn north just west of Conecuh River. Go about 1 mile. Survey begun June 11, 1967 by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar and Alice Folmar and completed May 29, 1971 by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar and son Roy.
- 36 **Goshen City Cemetery.** Located at Goshen, Ala. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar May 24, 1971.
- 37 **Greenhills Memorial Park.** Located south of Highway 29 west of Troy, Ala. Copied by E. H. Hayes July 10, 1971.

- 38 **Griffin Family.** Located on Highway 29 between Banks and Troy. Copied by John P. Johnston Sept. 10, 1970.
- 39 **Hales Chapel Baptist Church.** Located north side Highway 29 west of Troy. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar and Miss Joyce Folmar June 16, 1971.
- 40 **Hamilton Cross Roads Church of Christ.** Located at Hamilton Cross Roads Highway 231 south of Brundidge. Copied by E. H. Hayes Oct. 31, 1970.
- 41 **Harmony Baptist Church.** Located on Old Highway 231 north of Troy. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 25, 1971.
- 42 **Head Family.** Located above Highway 29. Leave this highway at Mill's Store, go north turn right at Green's store, go past the Hamp Shirley place, turn left on a dirt road and go for about three miles. There are only two graves a piece from the road on the right. Can't be seen until you are near them. This land was once owned by the Motes family. From the personal files of Mrs. Henry W. Folmar May 17, 1971. The two inscriptions are John Melton Head and Legina C. Long.
- 43 **Henderson Family.** Located on property of Mrs. Shirley Smart Wilkins in Palmyra Community. Copied by Elizabeth Hilliard. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Page 34 April 1962. There are 12-14 graves in this cemetery but only the three listed are marked. Others known to have been buried in the cemetery include: Willis Evans, Dr. Daly (A Friend), Jim Ship, Shadrack Henderson (Brother of Eli Henderson). Shadrack Henderson Married Eliza Darby, Sister of Mary Darby. Eliza is buried in Oakwood Cemetery, Troy, Ala.
- 44 **Hephzibah Church.** Located four miles South of Troy on the Three Notch road. Copied by Ora Lee Park and Roy Park in 1954. Resurveyed by E. H. Hayes Oct. 16, 1971.
- 45 **Hilliard's Cross roads or Bethel Baptist Church.** Surveyed by E. H. Hayes Nov. 13, 1971.
- 46 **Hilliard Howard Family.** Located four and one-half miles south of Troy, Ala. One and one-half miles west of the Three Notch Road. Copied by Ora Lee Park and Roy Park in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Page 21 April 1962. Three inscriptions viz: Hilliard, Mary Ann and Minnie M. Howard.
- 47 **Hinston Cemetery.** Located across the road from Green Hills Memorial Park Highway 29 west of Troy. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar June 10, 1971.
- 48 **Hopewell Primitive Baptist Church.** Located east of Henderson. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar 1966 and resurveyed by her and daughter, Joyce, May 24, 1971.
- 49 **Howard Family.** Located on east side of county road 49 just south of Murphy's church. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 25, 1971.
- 50 **Hussey Family.** Located Highway 223 near Westminster Presbyterian church. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 23, 1971.
- 51 **Jack McPherson Home.** Buried in the garden of a home later known as the Jack McPherson Home, Little Oak, Pike Co. Ala. Copied by Ruth McPherson Brown in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Page 12 April 1962. One Inscription viz: Jesse Lightfoot.
- 52 **Johnson Cemetery.** Located in Coston Curtis' Pasture. S.W. of Mossy Grove. Copied by E. H. Hayes and John P. Johnston guided by Rufus Davenport June 19, 1971. A single headstone of Elizabeth W. Johnson now laid flat down in a cement slab and cannot be seen until you are over it.
- 53 **Jonathan Williams Family.** Located on Norris Blanton's land near Brundidge. Copied 1969 by John P. Johnston. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. 9 No. 1 Page 5 Jan. 1970. A single marker. See Williams, Johathan.
- 54 **Jones Cemetery.** Located on Troy-Elba Highway one-half mile south of Troy. Copied by John P. Johnston April 17, 1971.
- 55 **Jordan Cemetery.** Located across the road from Goodhope Church. Copied by John P. Johnston and E. H. Hayes June 19, 1971. This cemetery once contained several markers. Now included in a pasture and only pieces are to be found. See Rebecca Jordan, only inscription.
- 56 **Kelley Cemetery.** Located north of Linwood. Copied by John P. Johnston June 10, 1971.
- 57 **Kendrick Family.** Located on Butter and Egg road N.E. of Troy. From the personal files of Mrs. Henry W. Folmar May 17, 1971.
- 58 **Lakeview Cemetery.** Located at Brundidge, Ala. Copied by E. H. Hayes Dec. 22, 1971.

- 59 **Lawson Family.** Located a short distance below Henderson in Pike County just off the Three Notch Road on property of Perry Locklar. Pine trees are planted around it. Part of a beautiful iron fence is still here. The other part having been taken by vandals in recent years. There were other graves but land was taken into cultivation up to the fence of the Lawson plot years ago. Surveyed by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar Sunday afternoon, August 27th, 1967. Three inscriptions viz: Booker, John R. and Panola Lawson.
- 59.1 **Lewis Family.** Located just below Henderson on Billy Drinkard's Place. Copied by John P. Johnston July 12, 1971. Inscriptions of Benjamin H. & Judge B. Lewis and Emily Glosson.
- 60 **Little Oak Methodist Church.** Located at Little Oak, S.W. of Troy. From the personal files of Ruth McPherson Brown record made in 1954. Later burials furnished by Mrs. Frances M. Jackson Sept. 29, 1971.
- 61 **Livingston Family.** Located east of Dunn Wood Yard between Troy and Banks. Take dirt road east, pass first road to right, go to first house, turn right up dim road to a house. Cemetery is located S.E. of this house in a planted pine forest about 300 yards. Copied by E. H. Hayes March 31, 1971. Two inscriptions viz: A.L. & Martha Livingston.
- 62 **Loflin Baptist Church.** Located east of Josie community. Copied by E. H. Hayes Nov. 11, 1970.
- 63 **McNeill-Townsend Family.** Located about 2.3 miles (by the road) north of the Orion-China Grove road between Big and Little Indian Creeks. TN 12 R 21 Sec 19. A good road at this time put there by Northern Paper Company. Surveyed Sunday Nov. 7, 1971 by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar and Mr. & Mrs. Toby Griffin accompanied by Amon Head and Jaffous Berry.
- 64 **Meadows Family.** Located four and one-half miles south of Troy. One and one-half miles west of the Three Notch Road. Copied by Ora Lee Park and Roy Parks in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Page 21 April 1962. Two inscriptions viz: Joshua and Susan Meadows.
- 65 **Mossy Grove Cemetery.** Located east of Highway 87 just south of Troy. Two surveys used viz: (1) John P. Johnston's Survey of March 17, 1971 and (2) Mrs. Henry W. Folmar's Survey of March 5, 1967.
- 66 **Mt. Gilead Cemetery.** Located across highway from Harmony School, Old 231 north of Harmony Baptist Church. Copied by E. H. Hayes March 5, 1971. Negro section not surveyed. No recent burials in white section.
- 67 **Mt. Moriah Church.** Located S.W. of Orion. Short distance west of Highway 231. Copied by E. H. Hayes Mar. 27, 1971 and compared with Survey made by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar Sept. 24, 1967.
- 68 **Mt. Olive Church.** Located on Highway 125 south of Brundidge. Copied by E. H. Hayes March 23, 1971.
- 69 **Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church.** Located north of Linwood Community. Copied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 23, 1971. Negro section not surveyed.
- 70 **Murphree Family.** Located on College Street, Troy, Ala. Copied by Kate Murphree Copeland in 1953. Recorded in "Papers of the Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Pages 31-33 April 1962.

### MURPHREE MONUMENT


James Strother Murphree founder of the Murphree family in Troy was the son of James and Sarah Strother Murphree of Louisburg, Franklin County, North Carolina. He was born Aug. 1, 1796. At 21 years of age he moved to Carthage, Smith County, Tenn., where he married Matilda Strother Dyer, Daughter of Joel and Mary Burford Dyer Dec. 20, 1820.

He came to Troy from Commerce, Tenn. in Dec. 1844 and died July 20, 1856. His wife died June 30, 1875. Their children were Mary B. Fannin, Sarah A. Love, William M. Murphree, Joel Dyer Murphree, James K. Murphree, Elizabeth F. Jones, Daniel B. Murphree, Benjamin F. Murphree, Edwin D. Murphree, Thomas M. Murphree, Almira M. Murphree.

- 95 **Philadelphia Presbyterian Church.** Located in southeast corner of Lakeview cemetery, Brundidge, Alabama. Copied by E. H. Hayes Oct. 7, 1970.

#### HISTORICAL MARKER

"First Presbyterian Church in Pike County. Organized largely by members of Beaver Creek Presbyterian Church near Camden, S.C. They petitioned Presbytery of South Alabama Oct. 18, 1839 and were officially established as a church April 3, 1840. Church was dissolved in April 1917."

Reverse side of marker: "Officers during life of church: 1840-1917. **Elders:** R. R., S. R., J. W., J. A. McLure, J. M. Thompson, E. Ruffin, S. Smyth, B. H. Boyd, J. A. Ramsey, G. C. Barnette, J. D. and Dr. J. A. McEachern. **Deacons:** John and Dr. J. A. McEachern, John W. Thomas C., Henry M., Richard U. McLure, W. F. Ferrell, W. A. E. Helms. **Ministers:** D. S. McCormick, A. M. Mooney, M. A. Patterson, A. McMillan, J. M. Peu, G. W. Butler, F. M. McMurry, J. McKee, R. H. Hall, G. R. Foster, R. Kirkpatrick, W. H. White and J. C. Sturgeon."

#### GRANITE MARKER WEST SIDE

"This immediate area, roughly 80' x 105' with granite post at the four corners, is only a portion of the cemetery of the Philadelphia Presbyterian Church (1839-1917). A cemetery that contained mostly unmarked graves. The markers within this area are at the graves of some of the descendants of John McLure, of the Beaver Creek Presbyterian Church in Kershaw District, South Carolina, through his son, Richard Rankin McLure (1783-1858) and some family connections. The church building was to the north of the Cemetery."

- 96 **Pleasant Hill Church.** Located west of Highway 49 just north of Troy. Copied by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar Sept. 17, 1967 and recopied by E. H. Hayes Feb. 25, 1971.
- 97 **Pleasant Hill Methodist Church.** Located in the Josie Community. Copied by E. H. Hayes Nov. 13, 1971.
- 98 **Providence Cemetery.** Located about three miles west of Bethel Church SW of Banks, Ala. Copied by John P. Johnston in 1969. Rechecked by E. H. Hayes Nov. 3, 1971.
- 99 **Pugh Family.** From the Troy Messenger, June 29, 1921. "On the way to Monticello, Mr. Tatom pointed out the stone which marked the last resting place of Robert Pugh, father of Senator James L. Pugh, who served Alabama for 12 years or more in the Senate of the United States. The grave is situated in a cotton field about fifty yards from the Troy-Eufaula road. The Chinese custom of cultivating the ancestral grave is not quite followed in this instance for the cotton is not planted directly upon the grave, but is so close that the branches will lap across the mound if the stalks reach their growth. The inscription tells that Robert Pugh died August 5, 1831 at the age of 47 years. The place where he was buried was once the prosperous and populous Harrell Hobdy Community."

#### Brundidge News October 5, 1895

"An unmarked grave — Not many persons, perhaps, are aware of the fact that the ashes of Senator James L. Pugh's father rest in the bosom of Pike County. Such is true, nevertheless. Mr. Pugh, Senior was buried in a private cemetery on what is known as the Ed. Hobdy Place, on the Hobdy's Bridge road about ten miles from Brundidge. We are informed that the remains of an old headstone are yet standing but the spot is so overgrown with underbrush, grass and weeds that there is so little to indicate to the passer-by of the paternal ancestor of so distinguished a son of Alabama."

- 100 **Ramah Primitive Baptist Church.** Located in Josie Community. Copied by E. H. Hayes Nov. 7 & 21, 1970, Jan. 2, 23 & 30, 1971. Accompanied by Mr. Fletcher R. Copeland who furnished many details from memory. He was caretaker of the cemetery for several years.
- 101 **Renfroe or First Mt. Zion Cemetery.** Located in Josie Community. Copied by E. H. Hayes Nov. 7, 1970.
- 102 **Rhods Cemetery.** Located on Chris Townsend land west of Highway 87. From Troy pass the paved road to Pike County public lake. Turn right on first dirt road. Go to first house on right. The cemetery is hidden about 3/4 mile behind this house. Copied June 19, 1971 by E. H. Hayes

and John P. Johnston guided by Mr. Rufus Davenport. Two inscriptions, Annie and Samuel Rhods.

- 103 **Richland Baptist Church.** Located near Pea River, North of Highway 10. Copied by John P. Johnston in 1969. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. 9 Pages 5-11 Jan. 1970.
- 104 **Rouse Family.** Located 1/2 mile north of Goshen, Ala. From the personal files of Mrs. Henry W. Folmar May 17, 1971. There are remains of a shelter covering a plot large enough for two graves. Mrs. Lula Lynn who was over 90 years of age when she died, told me that these were the graves of twin babies born to Nora Rouse Mickler and husband. The parents of Nora Rouse were Missouri Frost and Reuben Rouse. Family moved to Florida.
- 105 **Sanders Cemetery.** Located north side of East end of Homewood Ave. Troy, Ala. Copied by E. H. Hayes July 10, 1971. Three markers and one memorial stone.
- 106 **Sanders Cemetery.** Located above Ansley, Ala. and a piece off the road that leads to Briar Hill. Copied by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar and Mrs. W. O. Sanders in April 1967.
- 107 **Sandfield Cemetery.** Located at Zebulon Baptist Church Highway 223. Copied by E. H. Hayes Jan. 30th and Feb. 19th, 1971.
- 108 **Sanford Barron Family.** Located nine miles south of Troy. One mile east of Three Notch Road, on road leading to Palymra. Copied by Ora Lee Park and Roy Park in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike Country Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Page 21. Two Inscriptions, Jerry Darby Barron and Mrs. Civil White.
- 109 **Sardis Methodist Church.** Located between Richland community and Shiloh. Copied by John P. Johnston Nov. 12, 1970.
- 110 **Shady Grove.** Located at Shady Grove, Ala. This record a combination of a survey made by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar July 19, 1970 and a recheck made by E. H. Hayes March 31, 1972.
- 111 **Shady Grove Baptist Church.** Located on Highway 125 between Brundidge and Tarentum. Copied by E. H. Hayes Oct. 11-12, 1971.
- 112 **Shiloh Baptist Church.** Located between Monticello and Louisville. Copied by John P. Johnston in 1970. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. 9 No. 4 Oct. 1970.
- 112.1 **Simmons Cemetery.** Copied April 1, 1972 by John P. Johnston, E. H. and Brent W. Hayes. Official guide, Mrs. Clyde Gibson Burks age 84. Two markers found viz: Elizabeth and Issac Simmons, great grand parents of Mrs. Burks. Cemetery located in a planted pine forest on the property of Mr. Brantley Wiley. From Springhill go north on Highway 87 turn left on 2nd dirt road. Where the road makes a sharp bend to left, an old abandoned road goes straight ahead. Approximately 400 yards down the old road and 100 yards north of the road is the abandoned cemetery.
- 113 **Sims Cemetery.** Located 3/4 miles north of Highway 29 turning at the Floyd Boys Store. As in other old cemeteries there are lost graves here. Some with wooden stakes and perhaps some three dozen marked with iron rocks. This cemetery has recently been cleaned up and a nice fence put around it. Copied by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar Aug. 13, 1967.
- 114 **Smilie Cemetery.** Located on the banks of the Conecuh River, one mile east of Goshen. Copied by Ruth McPherson Brown in 1954. Recorded in "Papers of The Pike County Historical Society" Vol. II No. 6 Pages 12-13 April 1962. Dates and comments added by Mrs. Henry W. Folmar Sept. 28, 1971.
- 115 **Speir Cemetery.** Located just off the Henderson-Glenwood highway on a paved road that leads to the Fleetwood Community. Surveyed by Mr. & Mrs. Henry W. Folmar one Sunday afternoon Sept. 1966. Seven additions added May 15, 1971. A comment by Mrs. Folmar. "Thomas E. Jackson told me his father, Wm. M. Jackson told him the story of how a settler by the name of Speir came and settled on a hill across from this cemetery. He didn't know he had any neighbors until before day one morning when he heard a rooster crowing. When it was light he took an ax and started out in the direction of the sound, blazing a trail as he went. He crossed the river and came out about where the Curtis and Carmichael families lived. There he found his neighbor, but Mr. Jackson didn't know his name."

- 121 **Stinson Cemetery.** Located on Jones Street in Troy. It is in the back yard of the last house on the west end of the street. From the personal files of Mrs. Henry W. Folmar May 17, 1971. One inscription, Jason Stinson.
- 122 **St. John's Church.** Located at Tarentum. Copied by John P. Johnston and Diane Matthews in 1969. Rechecked by E. H. Hayes Oct. 16-22-23, 1971.
- 123 **Tennille Baptist Church.** Located at Tennille, Ala. Copied by John P. Johnston in 1969. Rechecked by E. H. Hayes Feb. 22, 1972.
