

<u>SUBJECT</u>	<u>PARAGRAPH</u>
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1. Authorization:

The plans for the interior defense of the State of Alabama are issued by the authority granted by the laws of the State and in compliance with Paragraph 7, Protective Mobilization Plan, State of Alabama, 1940.

3. Object:

To provide a plan for the interior defense of the State, and a Military Force to execute such a plan in case of a National or State emergency when no other forces are available or are considered inadequate to perform such a mission.

4. Scope of the Plan.

a. The Plan of Defense of the State is to insure:

(a) Adequate reinforcements to the State peace officers in case of a domestic disturbance of a major character.

(b) Immediate relief to districts within the State which have been devastated by the elements.

(c) The safe-guarding and protection of vital installations within the State in case of a National emergency.

(d) Instructing the population relative to airplane attacks, the organization and establishment of aircraft warning systems.

(e) A force acting alone or in cooperation with Federal forces to repel invasions.

b. The scope of Defense Plan #1 is limited to a and c above.

5. Military Force to Carry Out the Defense Plans.

a. General. - It is to be considered that in case of a National emergency of long duration, Federal and National Guard forces will not be available to carry out the mission embodied in this plan, therefore, in the expectation of such a condition, the State of Alabama, contemplates the raising of such force to be known as the Alabama Home Guard.

b. Alabama Home Guard. - (Ref. Appendix 1). State Regulations #4, will govern the policies, organization, personnel, administration and training of the Alabama Home Guard.

c. Under ordinary circumstances the command of the Alabama Home Guard will be as designated by State Regulations #4, but when this force or parts of same are operating with Federal or National Guard troops, they will come under command of the Senior Officer of the last named troops regardless of the rank of the commander of the Alabama Home Guard. When operating alone as the Alabama Home Guard and in absence of the State Commander, the commanding officer of the Area or District assumes command of all troops that are moved into his Area or District.

6. Defense Plans:

a. General.- The State of Alabama for the purpose of defenses divided into Areas and Districts (Ref. Section II, State Regulations #4). Sufficient troops are allocated to such areas and districts to protect the vital installations within.

b. Location of Units and Headquarters. (Ref. Map. 68- Appendix 5).

c. Intelligence to be supplied. (Ref. Maps 1-67, Appendix 2 and 3, Overlays 4 and 5). The information shown on these maps and appendices is to be amplified from time to time from these Headquarters.

(1) District commanders, (Ref. Overlay #4), will make a survey at once of their respective districts and submit to State Headquarters the information outlined in Appendix #3. It is cautioned that this information is considered confidential, special attention being given to important bridges as shown on Maps 1-67 & Overlay #4, and hydro-electric plants.

d. Intelligence Sections Alabama Home Guard.

The organization of Intelligence Sections to combat sabotage, espionage or radical groups is not contemplated. The curbing of these activities is a duty of the Federal and local peace officers. Other than the patriotic duty of reporting incidents and activities, official action is prohibited.

7. Plan of Defense. a. - Forces available. -

Until the large number of Federal Troops now stationed in the State are moved, the use of State troops to repel invasion is not contemplated. Under other circumstances, local peace officers, the highway patrol and guards employed by industries and corporations will bear the first shock of the disturbance. Should the situation become such that it cannot be handled by these forces, the Governor will order the Home Guard into service.

b. Areas. - General (1) In addition to the Areas, Districts and Counties as outlined on Map 68, there are certain areas which for the purpose of coordinating the defense of the vital installations therein are designated as Critical Areas and Sub Sectors.

(2) Critical Areas. - (Ref. Overlay #1 & #2, to Map 68). Separate Defense Plans for each Critical Area and Sub Sector will be issued as an appendix to this plan when the detailed information directed in Paragraph 6.-c.-(1) of this plan is supplied. Critical Area No. 11 is considered the most vital.

ternate route to Fort Benning.
- k. Sub Sector No. 8.....Dothan Area
Two Bridges Chattahoochie River, al-
ternate routes to Fort Benning and
direct route to Florida.
- l. Sub Sector No. 9.....Cockran Bridge, Baldwin
County
Main southern route to and from south-
west. Route to troops 8th & 9th Dis-
trict into Mobile.

c. Installations on border. (Ref. SS 3-6-7-8, Overlay 1, Map 68).--When an installation which required protection is located on a state border, the responsible officer of the Alabama Home Guard will co-

ordinate this defense with the troop commander of the bordering state. In case of lack of cooperation the defense will remain with the commander of the Alabama Home Guard.

d. Concentration Points. (Ref. Overlay #2 & Map 68). - Appendix 5.

(1) Past experience in case of industrial or domestic disturbances in the state show that the most satisfactory method of coping with such situations is to concentrate troops in "A Position in Readiness" and from a central point within the affected area handle the trouble as it arises. Concentration points (Red) on the Overlay are situated to suit the road nets which lead into probable points of trouble. Alternate concentration points (Blue) are located where reserves can be assembled to assist in an adjoining area or district.

(2) Sub-Sectors which are a responsibility of the Unit Commander designated for their protection will be covered by sufficient men to insure their protection so that the balance of the command can be used elsewhere. Installations in Sub Sectors, in case of general disorders, will never be left unguarded.

8. Supplies. (Ref. Overlay #3 & Map 68). Appendices 4 & 5. Section 4, Par. 14, State Regulation #4.

a. Rations. (Ref. Section IV, Par 13 c, State Regulation #4.

b. Shelter. (Ref. Overlay #3, Map 68). The use of Armories vacated by the Alabama National Guard will be taken advantage of whenever possible by troops of the Home Guard when on active duty. When this type of shelter is not available, advantage will be taken of the authority granted by Par. 14 c, Section IV, State Regulation #4.

c. Transportation. (1) Motor.- The Highway Department, State of Alabama has sufficient transportation advantageously located to move all units of the Alabama Home Guard. When

the situation demands that one company will be moved, the Unit Commander will apply to the nearest convict camp for the necessary transportation. District Commanders, to move their entire command, will apply to the nearest District Headquarters, State Highway Department, but responsibility for the equipment used by the Alabama Home Guard is a responsibility of the Commander of the Unit being transported.

(2) Rail. - In case of movement by rail, movement tables will be issued by State Headquarters.

D.- Medical- Reference Section VI, Par. 23, State Regulations #4.

E.- Communications.- Reference Section VI, Par. 20, State Regulations #4. Local arrangement will be made to use the Commercial Radio Network so that in case of emergency this method of communication can be used.

OUTLINE FOR INTELLIGENCE SURVEY

1. City and regional maps provide the best basis for showing desired physical information in its simplest and most usable form. To be of practicable value, location of physical features possessing military interest will be clearly and accurately located on the map, preferably by surrounding the feature with a circle of pronounced color, keyed by a number to a marginal or attached brief written description of the feature. In the case of areas of considerable extent, with definite or fairly definite boundaries, lines following area boundaries are preferred to circles. Among the features to be shown on these maps are:

a. Railroad passenger and freight terminals, depots, round houses, warehouses.

b. Ocean, coastwise, inland and ferry steamship terminals.

c. Bus terminals.

d. Terminals for railroad car ferries.

e. Street railway terminals, car barns, power plants and shops.

f. Airports and landing fields.

g. Central and distributing electric plants.

h. Vital elements of water systems, such as storage and distributing reservoirs, central points and pumping and filtration plants.

i. Gas plants and reservoirs.

j. Wholesale storage points for gasoline and fuel oil.

k. Federal buildings.

l. National Guard armories.

m. Police stations.

n. Fire Department Stations.

o. Other principle municipal buildings.

p. Hospitals.

q. Highest buildings or natural points of value as observation posts.

r. Wire and radio telegraph and telephone centrals.

s. Radio broadcast stations.

- t. Schools, theaters and large assembly halls.
- u. Public parks, squares, centers or similiar localities at which public gatherings habitually occur.
- v. Traffic density points or areas.
- w. Critical points, such as multi street inter- sections, permitting control of a number of approaches from a single point.
- x. Financial district or location of principal individual banks, where they are not in a group.
- y. Wholesale food district.
- z. Suitable detrainng points outside, but near the city or locality surveyed.
- aa. Federal, state and county prisons.

2. Information shown on maps will be amplified and supplemented by written statements and analysis of related factors and conditions, among which are the following:

a. Social Conditions:

- (1) Labor conditions with particular refer- ence to periodic or seasonal peaks of unemployment and concentration of labor in a few occupational lines.
- (2) Attitude of people as a whole toward local and federal law enforcement.
- (3) Charitable and benevolent organizations and extent of work they accomplish.
- (4) Prevalence of crime, its character and causes.

b. Inhabitants.

- (1) Population as shown by last national or local census. (Indicate which).
- (2) Percentage of foreign born or foreign influenced.
- (3) Attitude of foreign born or foreign in- fluenced toward federal and local authority.
- (4) Tendency of foreign born or foreign in- fluenced to concentrate in definite areas.

c. Rail Communications:

- (1) Number and names of lines.
- (2) Name and location of terminals or depots with lines each serves and headquarters offices.
- (3) Features, such as roundhouses, shops, bridges, tunnels, traffic bottle necks and switch control facilities, the destruction or disablement of which would seriously interfere with operation.
- (4) Location and brief description of features next above mentioned, including their susceptibility to damage or destruction.

d. Street Car Communications:

- (1) Number, ownership and names of lines.
- (2) Features, such as car barn, power houses, traffic bottle neck and shops, destruction or disablement of which would seriously interfere with operation.
- (3) Location and brief description of next above mentioned facilities, including their susceptibility to damage or destruction.
- (4) Local dependence on this mean of transportation at daily peak load periods.

e. Bus Communications:


