Mr. BOYKIN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Lands

A BILL

To authorize the sale of certain land in Alabama to the Chicago Mobile Development Company, a corporation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) the Chicago Mobile Development Company, a
4 corporation, is hereby authorized for a period of one year
5 from and after the effective date of this Act to file with
6 the Secretary of the Interior an application to purchase, and
7 the Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized and directed
8 to issue patent to such company for, certain land more par-
9 ticularly described as follows: section 37, township 6 south,
10 ranges 1 and 2 west, Saint Stephens Meridian, Alabama,
11 containing approximately six hundred and seventy-six acres.

1 (b) Such patent shall not be issued until after payment
2 has been made by the said Chicago Mobile Development
3 Company to the Secretary of the Interior for the land at its
4 reasonable appraised price of not less than \$1.25 per acre,
5 to be fixed by the Secretary, and shall not include any land
6 covered by a valid existing right initiated under the public-
7 land laws or found by the Secretary of the Interior to be
8 needed for public purposes. Such patent shall reserve to the
9 United States the coal and other mineral deposits in the land
10 together with the right to prospect for, mine, and remove
11 the same under regulations to be prescribed by the Secretary
12 of the Interior.
