# FRANK W. BOYKIN IS MAKING GOOD

Mobile, Ala.,—Frank W. Boykin, Congressman from the First Alabama District, is making good and he has not been in office but a little over a month. When Congress adjourned, instead of coming home like most of the Representatives, Frank W. Boykin remained on the job in Washington, working for various federal public works for the counties of his district. He has called to his assistance Governor Bibb Graves, Senators Hugo L. Black, John H. Bankhead, and many others. Alabamians who have visited Washington in the past few days say that the Congressman, a native of Bladon Springs, Choctaw County, is an ardent worker for his district. He is working for projects in Marengo, Wilcox, Monroe, Clarke, Choctaw, Washington and Mobile.

Congressman Boykin has secured nearly \$100,000.00 for public works in Mobile city and county; for Choctaw county, \$105,600.00 for roads leading from Ackerman; \$87,922.00 for roads leading from Butler and \$7,468.00 for sidewalks at Butler, Choctaw county.

Clarke county: Thomasville, street work, \$7,646.00; Warehouse at Grove Hill, \$761.00; improvements to school at Thomasville, \$1,738.00 and \$7,646.00 for street at Thomasville.

Washington county: Repair to school at Chatom, \$2,772.00; for new bridges, \$21,625.00; Chatom-Millary Road, 19,600.00; and Chatom-Wagar Road, \$19,600.00.
