

President Truman Might Attend Fishing Rodeo

A letter expressing President Truman's thanks for an invitation to the deep sea fishing rodeo at Dauplin Island August 5-7 has been received by Martin W. "Son" Thoss through Rep. Frank W. Boykin.

Signed by Matthew J. Connelly, the President's secretary, the letter said, ". . . We have no way at all of knowing what the President's commitments will be at that time and cannot, therefore, make any engagements this far in advance. I suggest you give us a reminder around the middle of July . . ."

Rep. Boykin said the President "also wants to come down on a deer and turkey hunt next Fall."
