FOREST FIRES ACT

The following regulation under Section 38 of Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes 1927, THE FOREST FIRES ACT, is effective as of July fourteenth, 1948:

No person who is not a bona fide resident of the Province and actually domiciled therein, whether such person is the holder of a travel permit or not, shall enter, by any means of travel including the use of seaplane or any other aircraft, any area of forest land set aside as a protected area under the Forest Fires Act unless such person is accompanied by a licensed guide within the meaning of the Game Act; provided however that not more than three of such persons may be accompanied by the same licensed guide. Forest land set aside as a protected area shall include the waters and lakes within such area.

Any person who violates the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offense and liable on Summary Conviction to a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars nor more than Five Hundred Dollars, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both fine and imprisonment.

THIS LICENSE AUTHORIZES YOU, your wife, and members of your immediate family under eighteen years of age, accompanying you, named below, to fish for Salmon and Trout by angling, subject to the conditions of "The Fisheries Act and Amendments" and Fishery Laws of the Dominion of Canada on unleased Crown waters, on leased or privately owned waters with the consent of the Lessee or owner and also within Game Refuges with the exception of the Restigouche Game Refuge. THIS LICENSE IS NOT VALID on the Restigouche and Northwest Upsalquitch Reserve Waters. ALL MEMBERS OF FAMILY covered by this license must remain in a party and be under the supervision of a licensed guide when fishing or travelling in the forest.

THIS LICENSE IS NOT TRANSFERABLE and must be carried by member of family when angling.

NOTE:—Angling for Salmon before May 24th is allowed only under permits issued on the authority of the Regional supervision of Federal Fisheries.
