NOTE.—This license is not transferable, must be carried on person when hunting, and must
be exhibited to any game warden or other person upon request.

No person shall alter, change, loan, or transfer to another any license issued to him in pur-
sue of this Act, nor shall any person other than the one to whom it is issued use such license;
and each of such licenses shall expire the 30th day of June next succeeding its issuance. (Subdiv.
J, Sec. 11, Alaska Game Law, Act of January 13, 1925—43 Stat., 739.)

Each person to whom a license is issued to take animals or birds * * * shall keep records
which shall show the kind and number of each species of animals or birds so taken, * * *
under such license, * * * and shall, on or before thirty days after the expiration of his
license, make a written report to the commission on a form prepared and furnished by it setting
forth in full the data herein required to be recorded. * * * Any licensee who shall fail
correctly to keep such records or who shall fail to submit such report or who shall in any such
report knowingly falsely state any such data or who shall refuse to exhibit his records for inspec-
tion and examination as herein required shall be punished as prescribed in section 15 of this act.
