SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NUMBER 103

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Mississippi, the House of Representatives concurring therein that we do hereby respectfully invite George Wallace, the distinguished Governor-elect of the State of Alabama, to address a joint session of the Senate and House of Representatives at 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, November 27, 1962.
