## DIRECTIONS FOR KEEPING THE RECORDS, Etc.

---

1. All records are to be made in *ink*.
2. Use the following symbols in keeping the record of attendance:

	Absent all day.
<sup>1</sup>	Absent forenoon.
<sup>2</sup>	Absent afternoon.
└	Tardy.

  - o Used in connection with the first four symbols to signify "excused."
  - \* Used in connection with the first four symbols to denote that the absence or tardiness was caused by death in family or religious obligation.
3. If a pupil enters school after the opening day, mark the date of entrance by writing "E" in the proper space. In like manner use "W" to indicate the date of withdrawal, and "R" the date of re-entry.
4. A monthly record is to be made of each pupil's work, the following numerals being used:
  1. Excellent, 90 to 100.
  2. Good, 80 to 90.
  3. Fair (passably or moderately good), 60 to 80.
  4. Deficient (not coming up to the standard for "passing"), 40 to 60.
  5. Failed, below 40.In determining the standing of a pupil, the teacher should take into account the work done day by day, as well as the results of any special tests or examinations that may be submitted.
5. Deportment is to be marked as follows:

Ex.—Excellent. G.—Good. N. S.—Not satisfactory.
6. Report cards are to be sent to parents on the Tuesday following the close of each school month.
