



ALABAMA'S 49th GOVERNOR

JOHN PATTERSON, whose inauguration as Alabama's 49th Governor marks a significant milestone in state history, has had a meteoric rise to the top of the political ladder.

He entered the public service just four years ago, following his election to the attorney-generalship. His term in that important office was made notable by his ability, his courage and his high devotion to the people's interest.

His outstanding record as Attorney-General established him as one of the most popular and dedicated public servants of modern times—and he carried with him into the governor's race last year a full measure of public confidence. This background of distinguished service, and his demonstrated zeal for honest, representative government, set the stage for his victory sweeps in the May and June primaries of 1958. His colorful, forthright campaign—and his refreshing slogan, "Only the People are for Patterson"—struck fire with the voters as few campaigns or campaigners ever had before.

Into office with him Governor Patterson takes the good wishes and support of all advocates of sound government. Proud of his great record as Attorney-General, the people of Alabama now confidently envision four years of progress under his able, dynamic leadership as Chief Executive.

In a message to the people urging their continuing counsel and cooperation, Governor Patterson says:

"A citizen of Alabama can have no higher honor than the privilege of serving as Governor of our great state. The public business which you have entrusted to my care will be carried forward honestly, vigorously and without regard for personal considerations.

"As your Governor, I will safeguard your constitutional government with its freedoms and opportunities. I will do all that can be done to foster the growth and development of our state. I will make our government as responsive as it can be to the needs, aspirations and desires of our people.

"Alabama's future is before us. Our state is growing. That we have problems is as natural as growth itself. But we have the courage and the vision and the vigor to solve these problems. Under a sound and sensible administration, with the help of the people, we will move forward together."
