In order to judge as to the practical results of the home garden a careful record should be kept of—

Labor.

Money spent or money value of manure, etc., for which you may not have to pay.

Cash received.

Cash value of products used at home.

Charge yourself with the following:

Your own labor at 8 cents per hour.

Horse labor at 15 cents per hour, or if you hire, at actual cost.

Fertilizer at actual cost, or a one-horse load of manure at \$1, a two-horse load at \$2.

Seeds and plants at actual cost.

Tools at one-third value.

Other items at actual cost, or market price.
