After an illness of some weeks, Isaac Grant, an old citizen of this county died at his home, five miles North of Greenville Wednesday. He was about 80 years of age. He entered the Confederate Army in 1861 becoming a member of Co. C, 33rd. Alabama Regiment. He made a good soldier and was a member of Jas. H. Dunklin Camp U. C. V., of this city, at death. Mr. Grant reared a large family, all of whom are grown. He leaves besides his widow a great many relatives to grieve over his departure.
