Raldwyn Co Dec 8th 1862

Dear Father

This is Sunday morning just rec
your letter by Paddock for which I was
anxiously looking. I'll proceed at once to busi-
ness, as the cars come up at 12 & it is about 11
now. I think the quickest plan would be
to consult a lawyer at Mobile, you get out
the writ from the circuit Judge, and I
do not think the commanding Genl has
any thing to do with it. As near as I under-
stand it, explained to me by Dr Roykin; you
simply appear before a circuit judge, and
make an oath that your son in the army
is under age. The civil law does not allow
this, and therefore he gives you the writ to
take me out. Dr says that he thinks there
will be no trouble about it, as it has been
done to his knowledge. Dr has gone out in
the country at present - so that I cannot consult
him again. I could get a certificate of disability
from the Surgeon but think it would not do
any good I am in a great hurry as the mail
has gone and I have to go about a mile overtake
