

Camp 5 miles East of Manetta
June 9th 1864

Dear Charley

Recd your letter
of 29th ult - a day or two ago. Recd
one from Mother of 28th ult day before
yesterday. All well at Portland but
old Dick, who is sick about half
the time. Capt. Cloudis is dead.

Mr Cushman expects to go North
this summer. I wonder who they
will get to preach for them.

Fumpseh is much improved and
if you join Cavalry, he will do
to ride. When do you think of
coming into the army any-way.
And what arm of the service do
you propose joining, Also
what company or regiment.

There are three men in this compan
ny by the name of Thomas with

all of whom, I am well acquainted.
Their initials are R.M., J.D., and
C.A. Thomas. All very clever men.
I could do the sum about going
to return pka. But the one about
the clock I could not come.
I gave it to several educated
men in the Co. who could not
do it. But a man by the name of Craig did
it very easily. I aind the answers of
both. Would like to have you send
some more. In the way of news I
have none of importance. There
has been some fighting on the
right-flank to-day. dont know
how it turned out. Gen Geo. E.
moves his Ad Bns every day or
two. We expect to move this evening
towards Marietta. The army is
still moving eastward. It now
rests on the rail-road. Hoping
to hear from you shortly I am

Answer

If 30 there, and 30 back: B
pays A — \$1.³⁰ or 3½ cents a mile

If only 30 there and back.
B. pays A — \$1.¹⁰ or 3 cents a mile

Four miles from C. I. B-gets in with A. and goes to W and back. So that A rides (8) eight miles further than B.

How much would B have to pay A. for the hire of buggy

You do not say whether it is 30 miles to, and 30 back or, only 30 there, and back

Answer

If 30 there, and 30 back: B pays A-~~1.30~~ 1.30 or $2\frac{1}{2}$ cents a mile

If only 30 there and back B. pay A--~~1.10~~ 1.10 or 5 cents a mile

What time between the hours of six and seven oclock will the hour and minute hand of a ~~clock~~ be exactly together. Answer $32 \frac{8}{11}$ minutes after six.
