Has Dr. dismounted Cavalry
Macon Ga. February 23/65

Dear Mother

Arrived at this place without
trouble this evening. Where we are wait-
ing for the Command. It will
be here to-morrow. We will then get our
horses and avoid the walk between the
Milledgeville and Augusta. Brought the
rations through all safe and will sur-
prise the boys to-morrow. Expenses so
far only 10⁰⁰ though board was \$40⁰⁰
per day at Montgomery. Put Lide; & Gung-
blood at Montgomery; Elm Bluff. Hauled
John Jones package at Montgomery. Cost
\$1.50 He gave me 10⁰⁰, pay the difference
if he wishes.

Charleston is reported vaccinated and
as it has not been contradicted, suppose

it to be so. The furloughed men going
back are all in good spirits. dont know
how the balance of army is.

Mason is quite a fast place. Does
not look much like war times here.
Stores all full &c.

As it is just dark and a friend
is hurrying me shall have to say

Dear Mother,

Arrived at this place without trouble this evening. Where we are waiting for the command which will be here to-morrow. We will then get our horses and avoid the walk between the Milledgeville and Augusta. Brought the rations through all safe and will surprise the boys to-morrow. Expenses so far only 15.00 though board was ~~#~~ 40.00 pr day at Montgomery. Met Lide, & Youngblood at Elm Bluff. Mailed John Jones package at Montgomery. Cost ~~#~~ 1.50 He gave me 10.00, pay the differance if he wishes.

Charleston is reported evacuated and as it has not been contradicted, suppose it to be so. The furloughed men going back are all in good spirits. Dont know how the balance of army is.

Macon is quite a fast place. Does not look much like war times here. Stores all full &c.
