my residence at the Brazos, Mr. Woolf & Family is at  
this place, Major Taylor is at Point Isabel, with his  
family, Mr. Knowls went through here on his way to  
"Saltillo", -

Nothing new on this line except  
that Col. Butler who is in command of "Mier", sent but  
a small detachment of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Dragoons to a small  
Town called "Guerrero" some thirty miles from "Mier",  
and took one of the celebrated Guerrilla Chieftan "Gonzalez"  
second in command to, Governor Canalez, after which  
the Governor sent his Brother St. Canalez, to sue for  
peace, - Col B. sent him back and to say to his  
Brother, if he wished to come to terms of peace, he  
should have to come in person, - St. Canalez has not  
returned, with an answer, and it is not likely he will!

I expect this shall not be interesting  
as it is short, In haste -

Canalez has not returned with an answer, and it is not likely he will!
