

Satellite July 26th 1862

Dear Father

I write in haste as one of the boys is going home, to let you know that we are going to leave for Chattanooga in a day or two. We have been ordered to cook rations and be ready to move at any time. We expect to go via Montgomery - will try to telegraph you from Mobile and let you know what time we'll arrive in Montgomery. Expect we will be on scanty rations about the time we get to Montgomery. However we may go across from Seaber to Selma thence to Rome Ga. But I don't think so. The Mississippians do not like the idea of leaving their state. Our company is high glad to get in the Legion. Nothing would do them more good than to go to Chattanooga. Brother Jim and myself will.

Saltillo July 28th 1862
