

Alabama can well be proud of George C. Wallace, Jr., whose Inauguration today places him as its fiftieth Governor.

Born on August 25, 1919 in Clio, Alabama, he developed political aspirations at a very early age and most of his 43 years have been dedicated to public service. The struggle has been hard but his conscientious application to whatever position he has held has made him outstanding and his personal record could serve as an inspiration to anyone in any field of endeavor.

Every great achievement started out as a dream and Wallace's dream of becoming Governor lived with him during his years of preparation, as he disciplined himself to a life of service.
