NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE BIRMINGHAM AL
640 AM CDT SAT JUL 4 1987

VERY HEAVY RAINFALL IN NORTH CENTRAL AND NORTHEAST ALABAMA
WILL CAUSE FLOODING OF SMALL STREAMS...ROADWAYS...AND LOW
LYING AREAS THIS MORNING.

UNTIL MID MORNING...SOME OF THE HEAVIEST RAIN WILL BE OVER
DAKOTA...DEARBORN...NORTH TALLADEGA...NORTH CLAY AND
NORTH RANDOLPH COUNTIES.

YOU SHOULD BE EXTREMELY CAREFUL IF YOU ARE IN AREAS THAT
FLOOD EASILY. DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH RAPIDLY MOVING WATER
AND BE READY TO MOVE TO SAFETY IF FLOODING DEVELOPS OR A
FLASH FLOOD WARNING IS ISSUED.

FIVE INCHES OF RAIN FELL DURING THE NIGHT AT STEELE IN
NORTH ST CLAIR COUNTY AND OVER FOUR INCHES IN RADSDEN. THERE
WERE TORRENTS OF RAIN ALSO IN CHILMAN AND BLOUNT COUNTIES...
RESULTING IN SERIOUS FLOODING EARLY THIS MORNING IN THE
ONEONTA AREA.

...THE BLOUNT COUNTY EMS OFFICE REPORTED AT 615 AM THAT
SERIOUS FLOODING HAD OCCURRED IN ONEONTA. WATER WAS IN
STORES AND IN THE BASEMENT OF THE ONEONTA HOSPITAL.
OVER SIX INCHES OF WATER WAS OVER U. S. 231 AND DRIVING
WAS DANGEROUS.

AT HANCEVILLE...IN CHILMAN COUNTY...THERE WAS 3.65 INCHES OF
RAIN OVERNIGHT.
