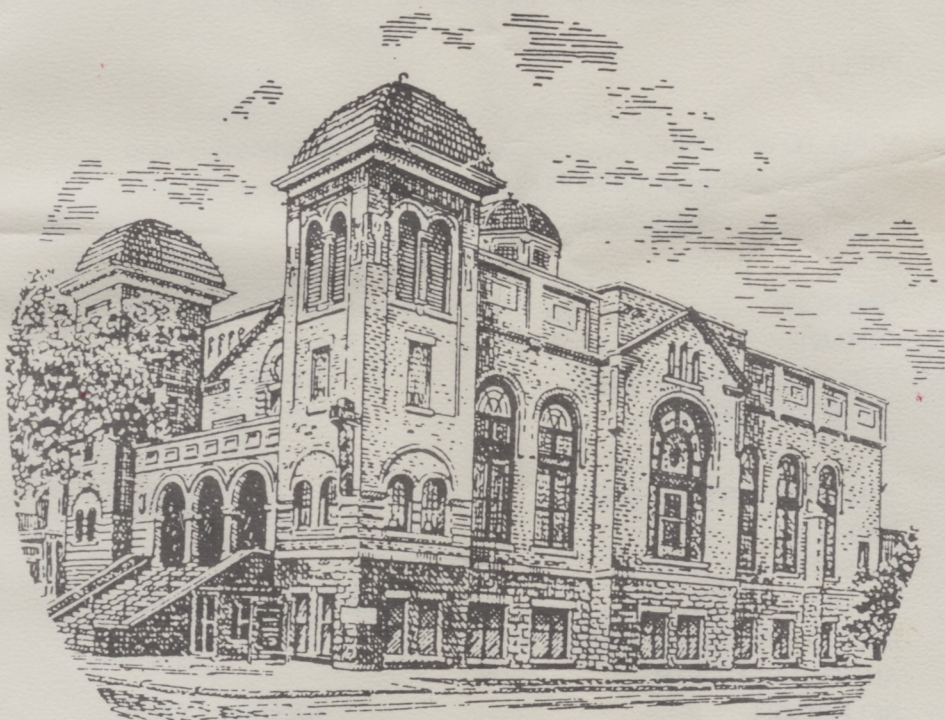

Sixteenth Street Baptist Church will observe the twenty-fifth anniversary of the bombing of the church on Sunday, September 11, at the morning worship hour. The bombing which killed four young girls received world-wide attention. For the first time the tragedy will be discussed in the church by persons in the area of the incident at the time, Mrs. Carolyn Maull McKinstry and Mrs. Bettye Lowe Ellington. Mrs. Bette Lee Hanson, Channel 13 reporter at the time and David Vann, former mayor, will give their thoughts on the bombing.

Two young men who were born several years after the bombing, Greg Butrus, a senior at Mountain Brook High School, and Anoop Mishra, a senior at Homewood High School, will give their feelings. Miss Bonita Conley, a young opera singer, will sing two black spirituals.

On Thursday, September 15, a city-wide observance of the anniversary of the bombing will be held in Kelly Ingram Park and the church.

The public is invited to both observances. Admission is free.
