Birmingham Aero AIR Show '92 Promises Spectacular Family Fun September 12-13

The world famous Holiday Inn/Coca-Cola Aerobatic Team headlines Air Show '92, next Saturday and Sunday (Sept. 12 & 13), at Shelby County Airport. Gates open at 10 a.m. both days with the opportunity to see, touch and photograph many aircraft on display, sponsored by the Birmingham Aero Club Air Safety Foundation.

This year's chairman Jon Green said the Pitts Special 4-man team will perform close formation high-speed aerobatics beginning at 2 p.m. Saturday and Sunday with other acts which include the Henley brothers performing aerobatics in their WW II vintage P-51 and AT-6 Texan. Comedy flying by a J-3 Cub, fly by appearances by the Air National Guard 117th Reconnaissance Wing Phantom jets, and parachute jumps will be presented until 4 p.m.

In the spirit of air carnivals held in Birmingham since the '30s, Air Show '92 is an opportunity to bring the family, young and old, take an inexpensive plane ride with Aero Club supporters and meet the people who have made aviation, Green said.

Advance tickets are available at area Holiday Inns (call to confirm) and at the Southern Museum of Flight, which is one of the beneficiaries of funds raised by the Air Show. Adult tickets are \$6.00 and children are \$2.00. Tickets at the gate will be an additional \$1.00 for adults and children. Proceeds from ticket sales, program ads and individual donations will support air safety, pilot training for school students and the Southern Museum of Flight.
