RUST IN COTTON.

Several of these analyses have been made with a view of determining, if possible, what is known to the planters of these soils as the "Black Rust."

True rust is a fungus growth, similar in its nature to smut, mildew, &c. In examining with the microscope the various "so-called rusts" found in the State we find them entirely unlike in different sections, and entirely unlike in different seasons.
