GRAND JURY REPORT.

To the Honorable Wm. L. Whitlock Judge of the 12th Judicial Circuit.

The Grand Jury, for said County, at the Spring term 1874, beg leave to report:

That in accordance with section No. 4094 of the revised code, we have made a careful and personal inspection of the condition of the County Jail, and find the prisoners have been comfortably accommodated with a plentiful supply of good and wholesome food, and generally enjoyed good health. It is sufficient for the safe keeping of prisoners, as that class of jail will admit of. But owing to the construction of the building, there is a want of sufficient ventilation, (according to the laws of hygiene) for the enjoyment of good health, but as there has been no epidemic of any serious case of sickness, probably we are mistaken. Our oldest and most experienced member says, "I am of the opinion that it is very well ventilated, and better than it used to be, since they have put the air holes in the top of the room."

We find the bonds of the different county officers to be made in legal form, with good and responsible securities.

We have examined the books of the different county officers, and find the records and proceedings nearly and well kept. Upon examination of the condition of the county treasury, we submit the condensed report of Treasurer furnished our body. (Here report was read to the court.)

We have diligently enquired and true presentment made of all indictable offences committed within the body of the county, not barred by the lapse of time. We find the moral tone of the county good. All the citizens are in favor of law and good order. A large majority of the presentments were for petty offences, which could be tried by Justices of the Peace and the County Court, without the intervention of a Grand Jury. We recommended to all law abiding citizens to have all those petty misdemeanors brought before the inferior courts having jurisdiction, and save the expense.

We tender our thanks to the Solicitor for his instruction and promptness to our body; and to your honor, for the lucid charge and impartial manner in discharging the duties of your responsible office; and though last, not least, to our old, venerable friend, Henry Murray, Bailiff, for his attention to our bodily wants and comfort.
