This note, thus early awakened, will swell into the roar of the tempest before November next—and unless we have overestimated the patriotism of the Conservative masses of the State, the Radical party will be swept from Alabama as the west wind of Egypt swept the devouring locusts into the Red Sea.

A Disheartened Insurance Agent

A family named Kemper moved into a house in our row last week, writes Max Adler, and Benjamin P. Gunn, the life insurance agent, who lives in the same row, was the first caller. He dropped in to see if he could not take out a policy for Mr. Kemper. Mrs. Kemper came down to the parlor to see him.

"I suppose," said Gunn, "that Mr. Kemper has no insurance on his life."

"No," said Mrs. Kemper.

"Well, I'd like to get him to take out a policy in our company. It is the safest in the world; the largest capital, smallest rates and biggest dividends."

"Mr. Kemper don't take much interest in such things now," said Mrs. K.

"Well, madam, but he ought to, in common justice to you. No man knows when he will die, and by paying a ridiculously small sum now, Mr. Kemper can leave his family in affluence. I'd like to hand you, for him, a few pamphlets containing statistics upon the subject; may I?"

"Of course, if you wish to."

"Don't you think he can be induced to insure?" asked Gunn.

"I hardly think so," replied Mrs. Kemper.

"He is in good health, I suppose? Has he complained lately of being sick?"

"Not lately."

"May I ask has he any considerable wealth?"

"Not a cent."

"Then of course he must insure. No poor man can afford to neglect such an opportunity. I suppose he travels sometimes goes about in railroad cars and other dangerous places?"

"No he keeps very quiet."

"Man of steady habits, I suppose?"

"Very steady."

"He is just the very man I want," said Gunn, "I know I can sell him a policy."

"I don't think you can," replied Mrs. Kemper.

"Why? When will he be at home? I'll call on him. I don't know any reason why I shouldn't insure him."

"I know," replied Mrs. K.

"He has been dead twenty-seven years!" said the widow.

Then Gunn left all of a sudden. He will not insure any of the Kempers.

Useless Expenditures.

The Radical New York Legislature seems to be as lavish in employment of clerks and attendants as our Alabama Legislature. The other day a motion was made to appoint additional doorkeepers, and one of the members opposed it on the ground that the legislative doors were sufficiently guarded. Said he:

"I do not see the need of so many waiters in this House. I have slept three in a bed during my lifetime, but I never was so crowded as waiters are about this Capitol. They are so thick it is very difficult to transact business, and I can see no necessity for adding to their multiplicity. Is it the carriage or the money they are after? Where the carriage is, there will the crowd be gathered together. I hope members will have some regard for the feelings of their constituents in spending their money, and, out of ordinary benevolence, at least leave a little of it. This may be deemed 'niggardly,' as has been charged in some quarters, but I do not see anything niggardly in observing economy in spending other people's money."

Some of our legislators might have risen in their seats and said the same thing with truth. There were nearly as many officers connected with the House of Representatives as there were members. Committee clerks, hall keepers, doorkeepers, pages, &c., swarmed all over the State Capitol, and drew their pay with great industry.

The two Houses can easily get along with one-half the number of employees on the roll for the last two sessions, and it is to be hoped that this extravagance, at least will be stopped.

Washington Special to the New York Herald.

Demoralized Condition of North Carolina.

Senator Ransom, who has just returned from a visit to North Carolina, reports the condition of the State, so far as agricultural and cotton interests are concerned, as worse than at any time since the war. He states that while the cotton crop will be large the prices will be low, and hence not as remunerative as heretofore. The prices are lower because of the increase in the yield of the crop, and also on account of the foreign buyers having anticipated it by contracts when gold was high. The higher the ruling rates of gold, the lower the market price of cotton correspondingly is. The labor is disarranged, and there is not the same class of men in management of plantations as heretofore. The former planters seem to have become demoralized, and now accept positions on railroads and in stores at from \$40 to \$50 per month, giving up their former occupations.

The trouble that has overtaken the North Carolina farmers is due to their folly in abandoning the crops suited to their locality, and going into the cotton raising business. Until they go back to first principles they will lose money, and when they devote their attention to grain and tobacco the "good time will come again." The cost of fertility was communicated to the farmers. It is
