NEWS OF THE WEEK.

SOUP.

Lavinia, the Vicksburg local who killed Calhoun, has been acquitted.

The entire loss by the explosion of the Crescent City will foot up nearly three hundred thousand.

Case Matlock, the Red Creek murderer, has been sentenced to be hanged on the 26th of May, at 11 o'clock.

Jesse James, an old and prominent citizen of Saline county, Ark., was accidentally shot and killed on Saturday last while out hunting.

John Franklin, a colored waiter at the Wortham house, Memphis, was fatally stabbed on the 28th, by Sam Ridd, the steward. Ridd was not yet before arrested.

At Vicksburg, on the 27th, Thomas Calhoun, an ex-politician, attacked J. W. Lavinia, local editor of the Vicksburg, cutting him in the neck with a knife. Lavinia then shot Calhoun twice, and he fell.

Thomas D. Grundy, sheriff of Mc-Cracken county, Ky., has instituted suit against the Louisville Commercial for damages of \$25,000. The Commercial stated that Grundy was intoxicated while taking a batch of prisoners to the penitentiary.

The officers of the Belle Lee report that the river below Napoleon is higher than ever known. About 25 miles of the Chicago and Pine Bluff railroad have been swept away.

No further losses are reported. The White country adjacent to Chicago, Illinois, and Bolivar, Mississippi, are under water. No great damage is apprehended.

Col. Robert J. Miller, a prominent lawyer of Vicksburg, was shot and fatally wounded there by J. B. Spars, also a lawyer, who drove up to Miller's office in a carriage and sent the driver up for him. Just then Miller came down street, and Spars called to him. When Miller approached the carriage, Spars fired, hitting him in the forehead. Miller fell, and Spars fired four other shots into his body. Spars was taken to jail amid great excitement and threats of violence.

W. A. Simpson, gate-keeper of the Tennessee State Grange, announces the fact that according to the census report, March 4th, of the secretary of the National Grange, there are forty-nine granges in Tennessee, as follows: Bradley, 12; Marion, 3; Blount, 1; Polk, 2; Bladen, 1; Roane, 1; Greene, 4; Hamilton, 2; Washington, 8; Sevier, 2; Hamilton, 1; Hawkins, 1; Jefferson, 1; Knox, 3; Loudon, 3. A special from Helena, Ark., says the tow-boat Crescent City, from New Orleans for St. Louis, with a tow of five freight barges, one fuel barge and a trailing boat laden with thirteen tons of sugar, blew up at the foot of Montezuma island, ten miles below Memphis. Every part of the boat was blown into atoms and the tank in three minutes. The barges were all consumed by fire. The cause of the explosion is not known. The Crescent City is owned by the Mississippi Valley Transportation company.

At \$70,000, the Crescent City, a wife, who was lost, leaves six children, who are in St. Louis. His wife had accompanied him on a pleasure trip.

FOREIGN.

Ten hundred and fifty-five bales of cotton have been landed at Elsenore from the ship Charles A. Farwell, stranded on a voyage from Savannah to Haiti.

The French, until especially for laying cables, will begin on the 15th of April to take on board the cable to be laid direct from Great Britain to the United States.

A dispatch received by boat from Havana says it is reported there that the Spaniards lost very heavily in the battle at Quivira, Cuba, near the mouth of the river, and the remainder in possession of the field at night, the killed and wounded falling into their hands.

Marshall Jewell, United States minister at St. Petersburg, has signed a declaration respecting the Russian navy, and the manufacturers equal rights with those of Russia. This is the first treaty signed in both the Russian and English languages.

The Duke of Edinburgh and his Russian bride had a rousing public reception on their arrival in London, the duke being accompanied by a military band, the streets were jammed with spectators from Paddington station to Buckingham palace, to witness the royal cortege pass, and not since the dashing over the recovery of the Prince of Wales, has the city witnessed such a popular demonstration.

In the French assembly, M. Dabivert, a monarchist, moved that the assembly take a vote on the first day of July to decide the future form of government.

That it was impossible to make a constitution without first settling the question whether France was to be a monarchy or republic. The motion caused great excitement in the chamber. A heated debate ensued. Duke de Broglie spoke against the motion and it was objected to by 393 to 250.

The Great Eastern will start in August to lay the Portuguese telegraph cable from a point in the coast of Africa to the Cape of Good Hope.

The Virginia senate passed a bill appropriating \$15,000 for the purpose of encouraging actual land purchasers and settlers to come to Virginia. The bill of immigration will have authority to send three commissioners to Europe, two or three to be natives of Europe now residents in Virginia.
